THINKING OF PRODUCING A PERFORMANCE IN YOUR AREA?

Many of Riding Lights shows only take place because of the exceptional help given to us by local organisers, like you, who make performances happen in their own communities. Here's a brief guide...

- **Tour dates:** 26 Sept 9 Dec 2017
- Cost:

Option 1: £1500 (including VAT) performance buy-out. The organiser sets the ticket price and then receives 100% of any ticket sales (less VAT and payment card comission). For this option the fee is payable after the performance, enabling you to raise the money from tickets sales beforehand.

Option 2: A deposit of £600 with a box office split of 60% / 40% (with 60% to RL). Ticket prices set at £10 and £8 for concessions.

Option 3: A deposit of £300 with a box office split of 25% / 75% (with 75% to RL) and ticket prices set at £10 and £8 for concessions.

We anticipate that you will recover your deposit at around 120 tickets.

- Audience Capacity: approx 150 300.
- **Audience: Age:** Aimed at adults and young people aged 12 and older. The performance may be suitable for younger children who are familiar with theatre-going experiences.
- **Duration:** Two hours
- **Technical requirements:** The production is presented 'end on', with the stage at one end

- of the space and the audience looking towards that area just like in a regular theatre. We will be providing our own raised staging which needs a clear flat space on which to be placed. The total area we need is 4m × 4m (13' × 13'). The company will provide their own lighting and sound equipment..
- Number in company: Four actors.
- Dressing Room: Actors will need a dressing room and somewhere, preferably lockable, where they can safely leave personal belongings.
- **Parking:** Space to park and unload a Sprinter van (6.5m in length).
- Marketing, publicity and box office: We
 will provide all press, marketing and publicity
 materials and will supplement your own work to
 publicise and promote the event through our own
 channels.
- Meal: We ask that you provide a hot light meal for the cast at the venue, or nearby, before the performance.
- Accommodation: We ask that you provide
 the four company members with overnight bed
 and breakfast. This is usually in the homes of local
 people who are connected to your church or
 community.
